### Section 6 - Accidental Release Measures

#### Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures

Personal protective equipment should be worn when cleaning up spills. Restrict access to area until completion of cleanup. Stop leak if safe to do so. May be slippery when spilled.

#### Methods and Materials for containment and cleaning up

Contain spill with absorbent material, such as sand, vermiculite or other inert material. Collect and dispose of spilled material according to local regulations. Wash away remnants with copious amounts of cold water. Clean area by working from the periphery to the centre of spill or from the edge of the room to the centre.

#### Precautions for Safe Handling

Avoid skin and eye contact and avoid breathing in vapour, mists or aerosols. An eye bath and safety shower is recommended. Observe good personal hygiene practices and recommended procedures. Wash thoroughly after handling.

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**Conditions for Safe Storage**

Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Keep containers tightly closed when not in use. Store away from incompatible materials listed in section 10 including oxidizing agents, acids, combustible materials and sources of ignition. Protect from direct sunlight.
